**TOWNSHIP TO HOST ASSESSMENT APPEAL SEMINAR**

Hanover Township residents looking to appeal their property assessments will not have to wait long. On Wednesday, February 15, Hanover Township Assessor Thomas S. Smogolski will co-host a Cook County Board of Review Appeals Seminar with Cook County Commissioner Timothy O. Schneider. Starting at 6:00PM at the Township Senior Center, 240 S. Route 59 in Bartlett, Board of Review Commissioner Dan Patlak will be answering questions and accepting property tax appeals. Residents are asked to bring their Real Estate Tax bill to the seminar.

“Residents can attend the event to have someone walk them through the appeals process to make sure their paperwork is filed correctly,” said Hanover Township Assessor Thomas S. Smogolski.

The Cook County Board of Review will be accepting appeals until Wednesday, February 22. There will be no extensions to this deadline.

“This is a great opportunity for Hanover Township residents who feel that their property is unfairly over assessed,” said Cook County Commissioner Timothy O. Schneider.
