**TOWNSHIP DEDICATES HERITAGE MARKER AT CHURCH
CEMETERY**

On September 28, over 40 people attended the dedication of the Hanover Township Heritage Marker at the Immanuel United Church of Christ cemetery, 1500 Old Church Road, Streamwood. The Heritage Marker honors the final resting place of three Civil War veterans and several early settlers of the Township.

“Too often people focus on the nation’s history but forget about the local history right in their backyard,” said Hanover Township Supervisor Brian P. McGuire. “I think residents would be surprised at how much history we have in our community.”

Officials from the Township, Village of Streamwood, the Park District and representatives from the Streamwood Historical society joined church members in the unveiling of the marker.

A staff member from Representative Crespo’s office presented a proclamation on behalf of the representative that honored the dedication ceremony and the church for their support of the Township’s Food Pantry

This is the second marker to be dedicated. Earlier this year, Hanover Township placed a marker at Ahlstrand Park in Hanover Park to honor the naming of the park after Carl Ahlstrand, a former police chief of the village who was killed in the line of duty.
