TOWNSHIP TO HOST RECYCLING EVENT

On Saturday, August 13, from 8:00AM – 1:00PM, Hanover Township will host the second annual Recycling Extravaganza for residents on the Township campus at 250 S. Route 59, Bartlett. Vendors will be onsite collecting electronics, cell phones, car batteries, prescription drugs, books, magazines, eye glasses, hearing aids, tattered American flags, clothing, gently worn shoes, bicycles, fire extinguishers, propane tanks and much more. Document shredding will also be available at a two box, per resident limit.

“Last year we had over 1,200 cars come through the event and it was a tremendous success,” said Craig Ochoa, Hanover Township Highway Commissioner. “This year we are anticipating more residents with more recyclables.”
