SECTION TWO: The Township Supervisor is authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Township.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION FOUR: REPEAL OF PRIOR RESOLUTIONS. All prior Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Coast2Coast Rx Card - Hanover Township Marketing Agreement

THIS MARKETING AGREEMENT dated this 5th day of July, 2011, by and between **Financial Marketing Concepts, Inc.**, hereinafter "FMC" a Florida corporation, with its principal place of business at: 100 Executive Way, Suite 214, Ponte Vedra Beach, St. Johns TOWNSHIP, Florida 32082, in conjunction with IPPFA Benefits principal location 3963 W. Belmont, Chicago, IL 60618 and **Hanover Township**, a political subdivision in the State of Illinois, hereinafter "TOWNSHIP" with its principal place of business at 250 South Illinois Route 59, Bartlett, IL 60103

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, FMC has created a discount prescription card, to-wit: the *Coast2Coast Rx* Card, which provides discounts on prescription drugs to individuals and families, and

WHEREAS, FMC can provide TOWNSHIP the opportunity to offer its *Coast2Coast Rx* discount prescription card to its residents at no cost to the TOWNSHIP, and

WHEREAS, TOWNSHIP is desirous of providing the *Coast2Coast Rx* discount prescription card to its residents at no cost to the TOWNSHIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions herein contained, it is agreed as follows:

1. **Benefits.** FMC will provide its *Coast2Coast Rx* discount prescription card at no cost to TOWNSHIP and its residents. In addition to the discounts on prescriptions, the card will also offer discounts on imaging and lab tests through an arrangement with Prepaid Lab, LLC and Prepaid Imaging, LLC.

2. **Term.** This Agreement will automatically renew every year for another one (1) year term unless TOWNSHIP gives FMC thirty days (30) written notice to terminate, or unless earlier terminated by default.

3. **FMC's Obligations.**

a. FMC will provide to TOWNSHIP and its residents the *Coast2Coast Rx* discount prescription card at no cost to its residents or TOWNSHIP.

b. FMC will print and distribute the prescription cards for the TOWNSHIP at FMC's cost. TOWNSHIP will approve the card design prior to FMC's printing of the card.

c. FMC will handle all administration of the card including the providing of monthly usage reports to TOWNSHIP. FMC will assign a unique Group Code to TOWNSHIP for cards printed by FMC so that TOWNSHIP's usage can be tracked when the card is used at participating pharmacies.

d. FMC will distribute its *Coast2Coast Rx* Cards to participating pharmacies in the TOWNSHIP and to other such governmental offices (such as libraries, health departments, etc.) designated by the TOWNSHIP.

e. FMC will create a private label website for the TOWNSHIP to link to from its website that will describe the *Coast2Coast Rx* Card program, and where TOWNSHIP residents can print a card, search for participating pharmacies, and search for the price of their specific medication(s).

f. FMC, in conjunction with TOWNSHIP, will participate in media interviews and other press releases requested by TOWNSHIP.

g. FMC and its Pharmacy Benefit Manager will not use any resident's information except as necessary to process prescriptions, and for no other purpose whatsoever. Neither FMC nor its Pharmacy Benefit Manager will contact, transfer or sell resident information to any third party, and both FMC and its Pharmacy Benefit Manager are HIPAA compliant. ^{Neither} FMC nor its Pharmacy Benefit Manager will solicit cardholders to use Pharmacy Benefit Manager's mail order unless directed to do so by TOWNSHIP.

4. **Indemnification.** FMC agrees to indemnify and hold TOWNSHIP harmless from any and all claims: (a) arising from or out of the failure, refusal or neglect of FMC to comply with any of the provisions of this Agreement, and/or (b) occasioned wholly or in part by any act or omission of FMC, its Pharmacy Benefit Manager, participating pharmacies, or other FMC agents, contractors or employees.

5. **TOWNSHIP's Obligations:** TOWNSHIP will provide the opportunity for its residents to receive FMC's *Coast2Coast Rx* discount prescription card.

6. **Governing Law and Venue.** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois and venue for any proceedings shall be in Cook County.

7. **Notice.** Any notice required by this Agreement shall be in writing, by certified mail, to the address of each party first set forth above, or at such other address as may hereafter be designated by either party in writing.

8. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement contains all the rights, duties and obligations of each party, and this Agreement may not be modified or amended except in writing, signed by both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties have hereunto signed this Agreement on behalf of the corporate entity for which they have legal authority to enter into.

Niles Township - Coast2Coast Rx Card Frequently Asked Questions

What is it?

- The discount prescription card program helps consumers save money on their prescription medications if their prescriptions aren't covered by insurance.
- The free cards are distributed by Niles Township in conjunction with Coast2Coast Rx and may be used locally and nationwide at any participating retail pharmacy nationwide.
- The discount card is not intended to replace insurance.

How much will people save?

- Savings average over 40% annually.
- Discounts may be higher or lower, depending on the drug and quantity purchased.
- Over 60,000 brand name and generic drugs available under the program.

Who can use the card?

- All township and non-township residents regardless of age, income or existing health coverage may use the cards.
- There are no enrollment forms, no membership fees or restrictions on the frequency of use.
- Cardholders and family members may use the card any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance.

Is there a Website for information about the card?

- Information is available at Niles Townships' Website.
- Information also is available from the Coast2Coast Rx Card web site, www.coast2coastrx.com/nilestwp

Can a health insurance prescription card be used at the same time with the Coast2Coast Rx Card?

- Only one card can be used when filling a prescription.
- If a prescription is not covered under a health insurance plan, the Coast2Coast Rx Card may be used to obtain a discount.



Does everyone qualify to use the card?

- Anyone over the age of 18 may use the card.
- A parent or guardian can get discounts on prescriptions for dependents who are under the age of 18 years.

Are there limits on usage?

- A cardholder and their family may use the card as often as needed.
- Family members include all dependents, including grandchildren.

What does a cardholder pay?

- The cardholder pays the negotiated discount price or a pharmacy's retail price – whichever is lower.
- There are no charges or fees for the card.

What if the cardholder is a Medicare Part D participant?

- Due to a gap in Medicare coverage, Medicare participants may pay up to \$1,500 per year in out-of-pocket costs.
- The card may help Medicare participants save on their prescriptions while in the "donut hole."

Which pharmacies participate?

- More than 59,000 pharmacies nationwide accept the card, including all chain pharmacies and over 95% of the independents.
- Most pharmacy locations serve as pick-up locations for the card
- Go to www.coast2coastrx.com/nilestwp to search for pharmacies in the network and locations where the card may be picked up.
- Residents may also print a card from the Website.

Who issues the card?

- Financial Marketing Concepts, Inc., Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida owner of the Coast2Coast Rx Card, administers the program.

Is information confidential?

- Cardholder information remains confidential and is not resold to a third-party for any reason



Niles Township offers discount medication card — for pets, too

During the past year, Niles Township Deputy Clerk Kitty Kendrick has seen the demand for township assistance skyrocket as the economic recession has forced some people to cut down on their medical prescriptions or skip filling their prescriptions all together.

“We’re seeing more and more people going onto unemployment and having problems filling their prescriptions along with getting food and getting medical assistance,” Kendrick said.

On Tuesday, the township — which includes 102,000 people in all or parts of Skokie, Niles, Lincolnwood, Glenview and the Village of Golf — launched a program that Kendrick said should help township residents save money off their prescriptions and the medicine they buy for their pets.

The so-called Coast2Coast Rx card program allows township residents — regardless of income, age or health status — to save on the cost of medications for themselves and their pets.

Family members living outside the township are also able to take part, Kendrick said. She also said the Rx card are being distributed free of charge and may be used at all pharmacy chains and most independent pharmacies in Niles Township. The card provides discounts on about 60,000 different types of drugs, officials said.

“The way economic conditions are, and with companies cutting back on benefits, people are in the need of this right now,” said Edward Rahn, president of Florida-based Financial Marketing Concepts Inc., the company that issues of the Coast2Coast Rx discount card.

“Instead of skipping on the medication that keeps them going, the blood pressure medicine or the diabetes medicine, using the card, they can afford the medicines today,” Rahn said.

He said the company prearranges with all participating pharmacies to get the discounts, which are then passed onto consumers.

“We contract for a lesser price and that drives business into the stores,” said Rahn.

He also said the program saved participants in Sarasota, Fla., more than \$2 million last year.

“The discounts are real,” he said.

Kendrick said the program is being provided at no cost to the township or its taxpayers.

“When this came along, we just thought it was a natural to go along with what we do already in assisting the people, many of them seniors, of the township,” she said. “They are on fixed incomes. They have small pensions. Medicare is not doing a whole lot for them. Their social security is at a fixed rate. This is something that takes a little bit of stress off of their budgets.”

Another important aspect of the card is that it allows users to get discounts of their pets’ medications, said Kendrick.

“Some seniors may have a little dog for 10 years and sometimes they can’t pay for the dog’s medications,” she said. “It’s way cheaper to take it to the pharmacy than to have it filled at the animal hospital. You’re on a fixed income, you have your two seniors and they have their little animal. Why should they be deprived.”
