Hanover Township to offer summer tutoring

Summer learning loss is a concern that many parents face with their child. The Hanover Township Summer Tutoring Program may be able to help. The focus is on retaining and improving basic skills over the summer months. During this time mastering basic math skills will be highlighted, preparing students for high level problem solving. Reading fluently and comprehensively will also be covered to help students make connections, interpretations, and develop questions on what they're reading.

Certified primary and secondary education teachers, who specialize in assisting students with homework comprehension and completion, will work with small groups of students based on age, and subject matter.

The program fee is \$45.00 per child per semester; a payment plan is available. Student must live in Hanover Township and must currently be in Grades 2 through 8. Out-of-Township residents can call (630) 483-5799 for more information. Parents/guardians for the students must remain in the building during their child's Tutoring Session.
