**Hanover Township partners with the Bartlett Area Chamber of Commerce
for food collection**

Hanover Township and the Bartlett Chamber of Commerce are partnering to collect donations for the Township Food Pantry during the Bartlett Independence Day Parade on Sunday, July 3, beginning at 1:00 PM.

Attendees are asked to bring their donations to the parade. The parade will step-off from the intersection of Oak and North Avenues, head south down Railroad Avenue, Main Street and S. Bartlett Road, ending at the intersection of Main Street and Stearns Road.

The Hanover Township Food Pantry experiences on average 728 visits a month.

Most needed items include: personal care items (shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste); paper goods (toilet paper, paper towels); laundry detergent, dish soap, canned tuna and chicken, coffee, peanut butter, jelly, rice, potatoes, cereal, canned goods, macaroni and cheese, etc.
