Hanover Township to host property tax appeal outreach seminar

Hanover Township Assessor Thomas S. Smogolski, along with Township Supervisor Brian P. McGuire, and Cook County Commissioner Timothy O. Schneider will co-sponsor an appeal seminar on October 5 with staff from Cook County Assessor Joseph Berrios' office. Starting at 6:30PM at the Township Senior Center, 240 S. IL Route 59 in Bartlett, staff from the Assessor's office will be available to answer questions and accept property tax appeals. Residents are asked to bring their Real Estate Tax bill to the seminar.

"We often receive many questions about the appeal process," said Hanover Township Assessor Thomas S. Smogolski. "With this seminar, residents can have their questions answered and file an appeal that evening."

Hanover Township is open for appeals until October 13. For residents seeking to appeal through the Hanover Township Assessor's Office, the last day to file an appeal will be October 11.

Appeals filed during this period will be for the 2016 tax year, which will be paid in 2017.
