Holiday Happenings at Hanover

Township Senior Services:

Adopt-A-Senior Recipients

Our Social Services team is gearing up for another wonderful Adopt-A-Senior program year! We are thrilled that our Adopt-A-Senior program continues to provide necessities and gifts to residents in-need. We look forward to offering the program again this year! Be sure to complete and submit your application to Social Services no later than Friday, October 28.

In order to qualify for the program, applicants must be Township residents and over the age of 55. A single person must have monthly income less than \$1,485 and a married couple must have monthly income less than \$2,003. There is no asset requirement and special circumstances will be considered in addition to the income requirements. We ask that individuals attach proof of residency, age, and income to their applications. Please note that everyone who meets income eligibility can apply, but preference will be given to individuals who have not previously participated in the Adopt-A-Senior program. All recipients will be notified by mail if accepted for the program and when the care packages will be available. *Applications are required to be considered*

for the program. Contact (630) 483-5660 for an application or stop by the Social Services Reception desk before Friday, October 28.


LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program)

The LIHEAP Program began September 1 for income-eligible residents to receive assistance with gas and electric bills. Gross monthly income must be less than \$1,485 for an individual and \$2,003 for a couple. Please note that individuals who are 60 or older, or with a disability have first priority to apply for the program in September. Beginning in November, the LIHEAP Program is open to income-eligible individuals of all ages. Contact (630) 483-5660 for an appointment and to learn the required documentation. LIHEAP is available until May 31, 2017 or until funds are exhausted.

The LIHEAP Furnace program will also be available to individuals who are on the LIHEAP program and who have a furnace that is non-operational or has been red-tagged by the utility company. The Furnace Program restores or replaces an existing heating system to ensure safe and effective operation. All utilities must be connected before any furnace work can be completed. Contact Social Services at (630) 483-5660 for more details, and to learn what required documentation is needed. The Furnace program is available until March 31, 2017, or until funds are depleted. Guidelines and program details may change at any time based on direction from the State of Illinois.

Medicare Part C and D Open Enrollment: October 15 - December 7

Attention Medicare Beneficiaries! The Annual Enrollment Period for Medicare Part C (Advantage Plans) and Medicare Part D (Prescription Drug Plans) will take place from October 15 through December 7, 2016. During this time, Medicare Beneficiaries can review, enroll, disenroll, or switch plans. Any change in coverage will be effective January 1, 2017. We have a team of Social Services Caseworkers who are available to review your plan options and assist with enrollment. Caseworkers can also assist in finding cost-savings options for medications. Please be sure to bring a list of all your prescriptions, along with the quantity and dosage, as well as your Medicare Card. Appointments are required; please call (630) 483-5660 to schedule a time with your assigned caseworker.

Dial-A-Bus-Service

The Dial-A-Bus service provides transportation to Hanover Township residents that are 55 and older, or individuals 18 and older with a disability. The service provides a means of transportation anywhere within Hanover Township. Residents can take the bus to Target, Wal-Mart, Stratford Square Mall, to the bank, the library, the park district, as well as to medical appointments. The Dial-a-Bus service goes to Sherman Hospital, St Joseph Hospital, and St Alexius Hospital. There are three different times that buses drop-off and pick-up at the Hanover Township Senior Center located on Route 59 in Bartlett. This allows residents to participate in a variety of programs offered at the Center, including ceramics, painting, bingo and computer classes, to
