Streamwood resident appointed to fill Township trustee vacancy

The Hanover Township Board of Trustees voted at the November 1 meeting to appoint Khaja Moinuddin to fill the vacant trustee position on the board. Moinuddin will serve the remainder of the term set to expire in April 2017.
