**Hanover Township tutoring program to begin for fall semester**

Many parents and guardians are concerned of the impact on academic achievement and learning loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic. To better support students and their families, the Hanover Township Department of Youth & Family Services will resume in-person tutoring this fall to allow students the additional help to improve their academic performance.

Beginning October 1 and running 10 weeks, the program will meet on Tuesday and Thursday evenings at the Town Hall, 250 S. IL Route 59, in Bartlett. Students in grades 2 – 12 can register for one-hour sessions starting at 5PM, 6PM and 7PM. The tutoring fee is \$45 per student, per semester.

Students and tutors will be required to wear a face covering for the duration of the session. Everyone in the program will be required to complete a health questionnaire and temperature check before entering the workspace.

Certified teachers will work with students in small groups, with three students working alongside one tutor. Children who attend regularly and bring their school materials/assignments to each session improve in academic performance and become more self-confident.
