Hanover Township Mental Health Board awards funding at September meeting

The Hanover Township Mental Health Board approved \$3,500 in staff development funding to two entities during their virtual meeting on September 22.

Heritage Elementary School in Streamwood was awarded \$500 to train faculty and staff in a curriculum that assists children who have experienced trauma and abuse.

Community Alternatives Unlimited, a case management agency for people with developmental disabilities, was also awarded \$3,000 to attend a training that supports the agency's work with residents with autism as well as training for staff compliance with state laws.

The next meeting of the Mental Health Board will take place on October 27 at 6:30PM at the Township Senior Center (240 S. IL Route 59, Bartlett).

The volunteer Mental Health Board advocates for increasing the availability and quality of mental health, developmental disabilities and substance abuse services by allocating funds to nonprofit agencies that provide services to Township residents.

Hanover Township serves over 101,000 residents in portions of the Cook County communities of Streamwood, Elgin, Bartlett, Hanover Park, Hoffman Estates and Schaumburg.
