

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Hanover Township Road District (HTRD) is accepting sealed bids for the HTRD's pavement rehabilitation/resurfacing improvement project for Chapel Creek located in Cook County, Illinois, including, but not limited to, hot-mix asphalt pavement removal, hot-mix asphalt pavement patching, hot-mix asphalt binder and surface courses, thermoplastic pavement markings, and restoration in strict compliance with the Project Manual, Plans, Specifications, and Drawings prepared by Spacoco, Inc. (the "Engineer"), and the other Contract Documents (the "Project Work"). Copies of said bid documents may be obtained from the HTRD Clerk at the Township Office at 250 S. Route 59, Bartlett, Illinois, 60103, (kdolanbaumer@hanover-township.org phone: 630/837-0301), during regular business hours of 9:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, beginning 12:00 p.m. on Friday, May 30, 2014. A non-refundable \$25 check for printing costs made out to the Hanover Township Road District, must be submitted when picking up a packet.

Sealed bids must be submitted on forms furnished by the HTRD, and will be accepted at the HTRD office, 250 S. Route 59, Bartlett, Illinois 60103 (the "HTRD Office"). Attention: Katy Dolan Baumer, Road District Clerk until 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 18, 2014, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond, certified check, cashier's check or bank draft in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid amount made payable to Hanover Township Road District. All bidders shall be pre-qualified with IDOT to perform similarly sized hot-mix asphalt bituminous pavement projects. Bidders do not need to be pre-qualified with IDOT for bituminous plant mix nor do bidders need to have their own plant to bid and/or perform this project. No tonnage restrictions shall apply to this contract. All bidders should include their IDOT "Certificate of Eligibility" with their bid proposal and minimum qualification documentation as described in the Special Provisions of the bid documents. The Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/01, et seq.) shall apply to the Project Work.

The successful Bidder for the Project Work will be required to submit: (a) a Labor & Material Payment Bond and Performance Bond or IDOT Contract Bond each in the amount of 110% of the Contract Sum, naming the Hanover Township Road District, Hanover Township, the State of Illinois and IDOT, as primary co-obligees, in form acceptable to the HTRD, cosigned by a surety company authorized by the Illinois Department of Insurance to sell and issue sureties in the State of Illinois or (b) an Irrevocable Letter of Credit in the amount of 110% of the Contract Sum guaranteeing Contractor's obligations under the Contract Documents issued by a financial institution with at least \$40,000,000 in assets and a capital to asset ratio of not less than 6% in form acceptable to the HTRD, to guarantee the performance of contractor's obligations under the Contract Documents and the payment of all labor and materials furnished for the Project Work, including but not limited to compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act. Contractor shall also be required to furnish an IDOT Permit Bond as provided in the Contract Documents. The cost of said Bonds and/or Letter of Credit shall be included in the total bid amount set forth in the Bid Proposal. It is anticipated that the HTRD will award the Contract to the successful Bidder on or about Thursday, June 19, 2014. The Project Work must be performed in strict compliance with the Contract Documents and must be completed within twenty (20) working days. HTRD reserves the right to reject any and all bids, accept all or part of a bid, and to waive minor irregularities and nonconformities in any bid when it is in the best interests of the HTRD.
